

Beyond Limits Student Profile

The Beyond Limits! College-experience Program located at Bethany Global University in Bloomington is designed for young adults with Developmental Disabilities and/or Intellectual Disabilities (DD/ID) ages 21 to 28. Post high-school students younger than 21 will be considered.

The Beyond Limits program provides access to a private, tuition-based, Christian, residential college-experience for young adults who are not able to meet traditional credit-bearing college requirements and require adaptive programming and a modified curriculum.

Students with DD/ID most likely met high school graduation requirements on the basis of their Individualized Education Program (IEP) goals, rather than by meeting state and school district graduation requirements.

Students who are likely to be successful in the Beyond Limits program:

- Possess good social skills, motivation for learning, and a desire for independent living.
- Demonstrate self-control and the ability to work with others.
- Desire to learn, work and live in a Christian college community.
- Have work experience or the potential to work in an integrated community setting.
- Are able to take care of their own personal needs and navigate the campus independently with limited supports.

To ensure a good match, program participants will be selected through an application and interview process with the student and family. In some instances, students are accepted on a provisional basis. Depending on enrollment numbers and the fit for the program a student can begin during a semester or mid-year on a pro-rated basis.
